SPARKLING WINE - TRADITIONAL

The fizz is created during a second fermentation, where sugar and yeast is added to an already fermented base wine to create the bubbles. In most cases, the second fermentation takes place in the final bottle, except for Prosecco, where the second fermentation takes place in a pressurised stainless stell tank, known as the Charmat method.

SPARKLING WINE – PÉT NAT

Petillant Naturel (naturally sparkling) wines are made with a single fermentation. The wines are bottled part-way though the fermentation, allowing the process to finish in the bottle, capturing the CO2 which creates the bubbles. These wines are usually (but not always) left un-fined and unfiltered under crown caps.

Also, sometimes referred to as Méthode Ancestral.
